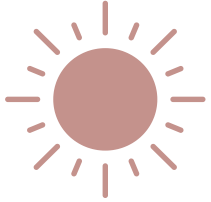


GROW YOUR OWN GARLIC



1. Select

Select a sunny, well drained position to plant garlic cloves.

2. Prepare

Prepare the soil so it's free draining and well fertilised.

3. Plant

Plant garlic cloves in early Autumn, 2 - 5cm deep, pointy end up and 10cm apart.

4. Water and Weed

Keep crop weed-free and well watered.



5. Harvest

Harvest in late Spring/ early Summer when leaves start dying back and the bulb has developed cloves.

6. Eat Fresh or Cure

Eat garlic fresh straight out of the ground or hang for 3 to 8 weeks to cure in a warm, dry, airy position.
